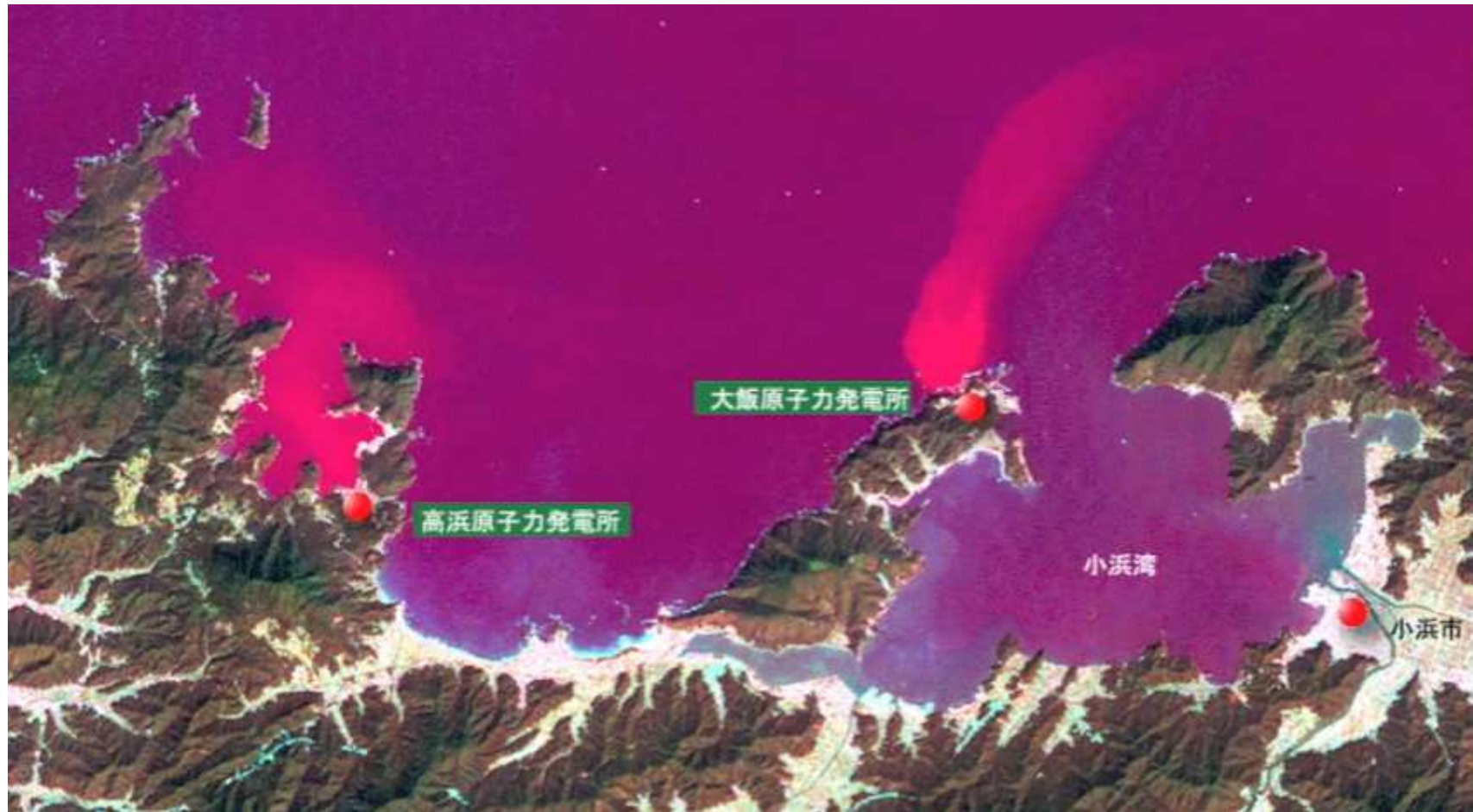

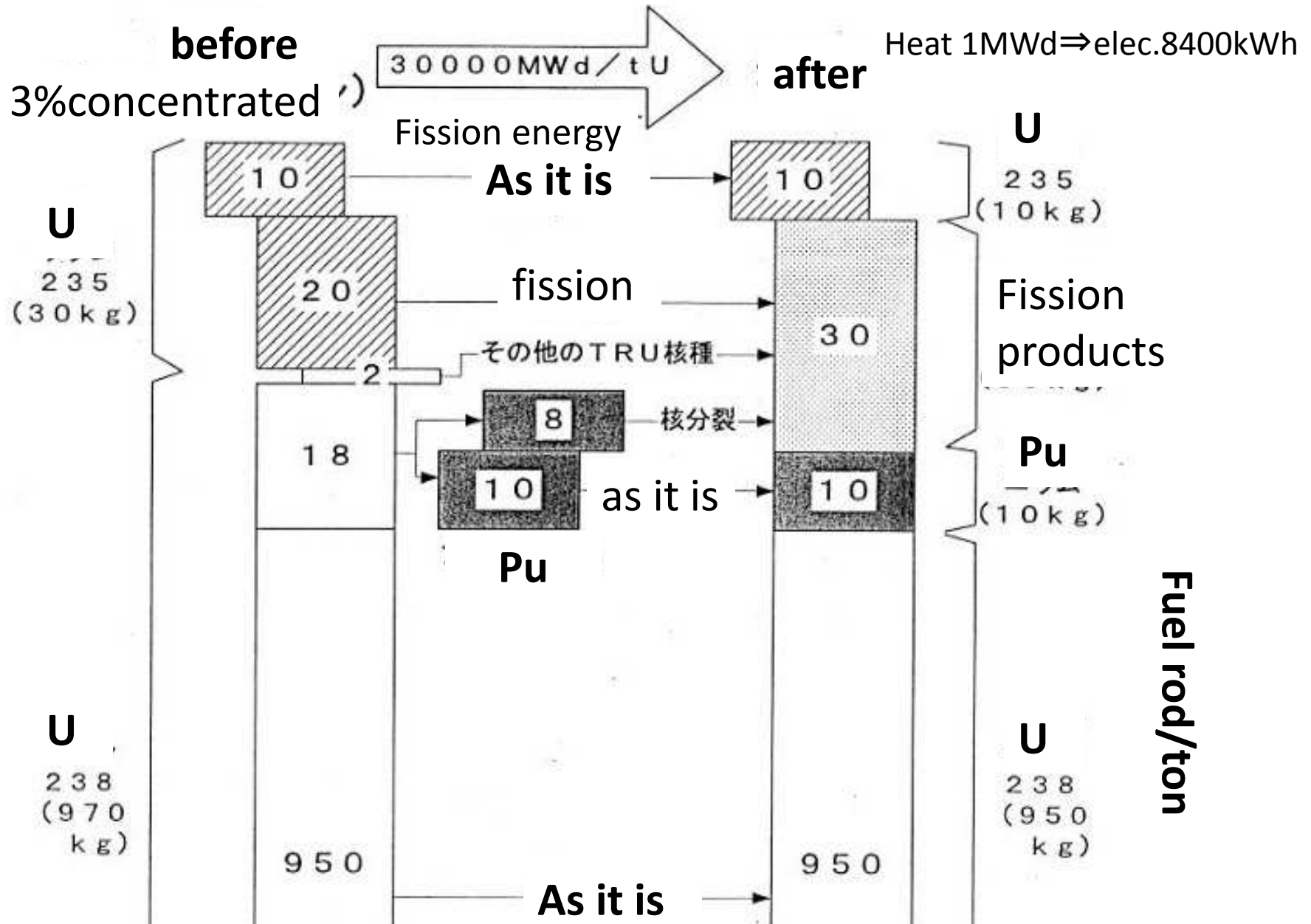
Warm Water leaking from nuclear power plants into the Sea



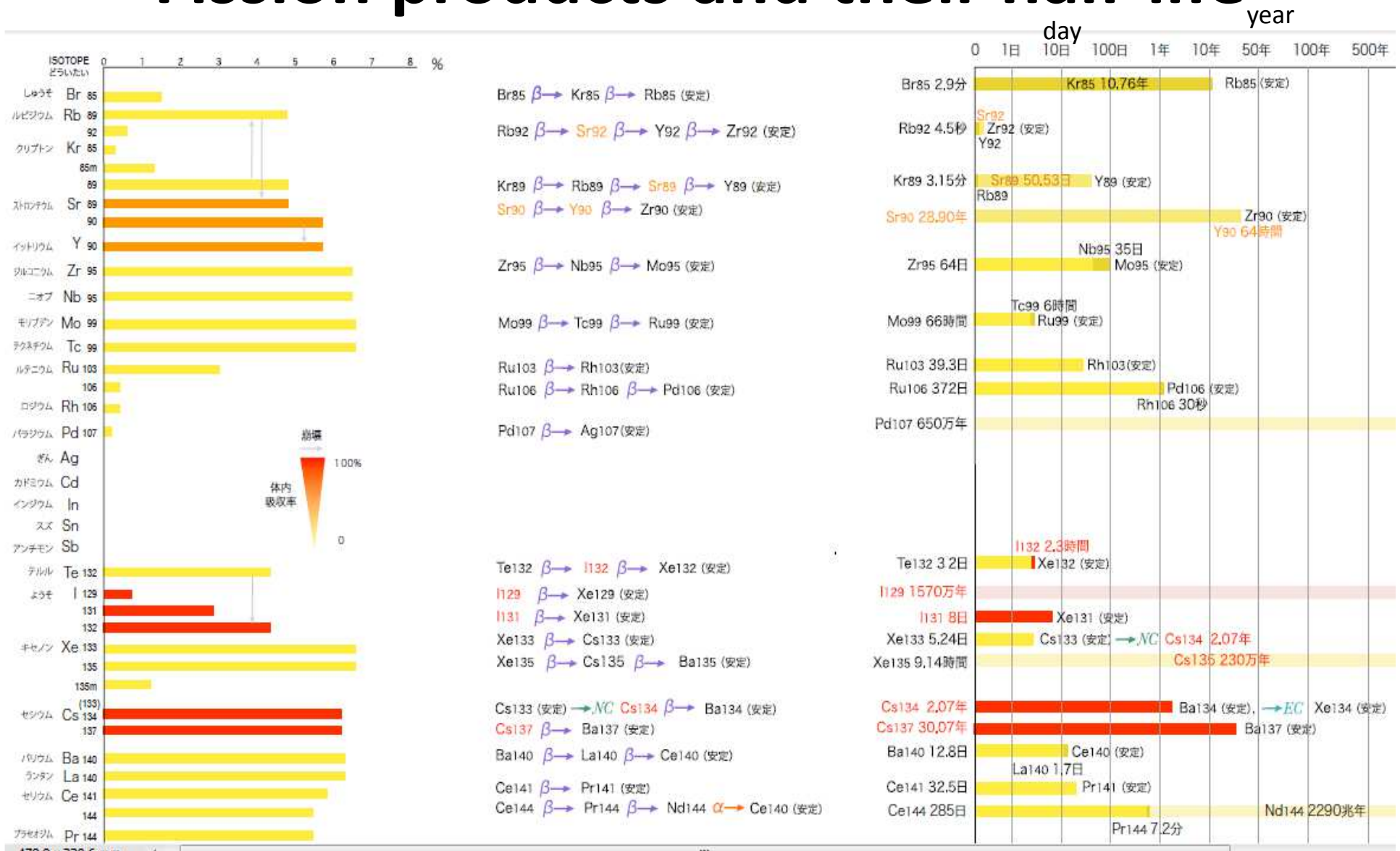
Nuclear P.P. as a Big Sea Warmer

- Two-thirds of the energy generated in NPPs are discarded into the sea or into the air.
- Prior to the Fukushima disaster, a total of 55 NPPs had been operated in Japan, causing a temperature rise of 7 °C to 100 billion tones of sea water every year.
- Climate change is caused not only by the increase of carbon dioxide, but also by the NPPs.

Conclusion

- Nuclear power plants are as harmful as nuclear weapons.
- Nuclear power plants do not prevent climate change; in fact, they worsen it.
- Nuclear wastes are of immediate threat.
- We should do as follows:

 2. Don't build or re-run nuclear power plants.
 3. Don't transfer nuclear wastes to other countries.
